2011 ALEXANDER VALLEY CHARDONNAY

90 points, Wine Spectator, July 2014
Nicely oaky, creamy and seductive, with ripe pear, smoky oak and toasty vanilla scents that gain depth, length and nuance, lingering on the finish. -JL

2010 ALEXANDER VALLEY CHARDONNAY

90 points, Wine Enthusiast, May 2013
Another deliciously drinkable Chardonnay from this fine estate. Shows the ripe tropical fruit and peach. Oak brings extra richness of buttered toast, but the whole is balanced with crisp acidity. Drink up. -SH

2009 ALEXANDER VALLEY CHARDONNAY

An aromatic, perfumed and floral white, displaying spicy apricot, fig and honeydew melon notes that gain depth and persistence. Drink now through 2018. -JL

2007 ALEXANDER VALLEY CHARDONNAY

Rich and opulent, with layers of fig, melon and honey-suckle flavors that are full-bodied, silk-textured, long and persistent, unveiling the vineyard's purity of flavor. -JL

2006 ALEXANDER VALLEY CHARDONNAY

It's a food group in itself, offering tiers of pineapple crème brûlée, lemondrop, cinnamon-dusted meringue, vanilla custard and buttered toast. Drink now. -SH



2004 ALEXANDER VALLEY CHARDONNAY

Ripe with sweet fig, tangerine and melon flavors that are elegant and creamy. Neatly tapered, long and smooth on the finish, ending with a dash of hazelnut. Delicious. -JL

2003 ALEXANDER VALLEY CHARDONNAY

Leading with rich aromas of sweet cream, vanilla and optimally ripened apples, this impressively filled offering fans out on the palate with luscious flavors that build on the richness and very deep fruit of the nose.
